

#### **PNGCS ICT Story Board**

- > 1993 first introduction of ASYCUDA,
- $\geq$  2005 the first version run on Windows (A++),
- ➤ Prior to 2012 we were connected only to few number of Ports, Customs Agents used dial up modems to connect to the system. Services were available during working hours only, (8 am to 4 pm).
- ➤ Since 2013 ASYCUDA available for 24/7 and connections via VPN (internet) with new virtualised server system.
- ➤ 2016 AW project Started and now in final stage of implementation

#### **Evolution of ASYCUDA in PNG**




ASYCUDA ++ the first version run on Windows PCs.





## National Revenue with ASYCUDA evolution 3500




### Our Current Technical Strength

  - Each Connected with Head Office,


- Some are already in optical fiber links,

  - To strengthen future communication,
  - One of the few Government Agency with its own Satellite transmission hub,
  - To facilitate the AW migration in remote locations,
- All most all declared Import/Export Customs Ports have been connected to the current ASYCUDA version including International Airport

Agent trigger release order in the system (the system will not allow for unpaid declarations)


System generates e-mail messages to Shipping agent and terminal operator with the release order.

Agents generation of Exit note

Acknowledge the exit note (at the gate or by Customs )

## Methods of Payments

- Pre payments (most recommend)
- Electronic Fund Transfer (EFT) to BPNG Customs
  Account (e-payment) (recommend)
- Electronic Fund Transfer (EFT) to BSP Customs Account
- Use of EFTOS (Up to 15,000 Kina)
