REGARDING COVID-19 VACCINATIONS – INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL

I, David Manning, Commissioner of Police and National Pandemic Controller, by virtue of sections 9(1)(a), 9(1)(r), 39, and 47 of the *National Pandemic Act 2020*, and all other enabling powers, hereby issue the follow authorization.

1. No person over the age of 18 is permitted to board an aircraft bound for Papua New Guinea unless they have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19 using one of the following vaccines:

2. An individual or organisation that fails to adhere to this Direction shall be deemed to have committed an offence under the *National Pandemic Act 2020*.

3. A person or organisation that allows a person to board an aircraft bound for Papua New Guinea in breach of this Direction shall be deemed to have committed an offence under the *National Pandemic Act 2020*.

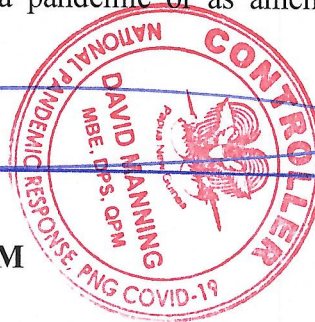
