DIRECTION REGARDING COVID-19 VACCINATIONS – INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL

- I, David Manning, Commissioner of Police and National Pandemic Controller, by virtue of sections 9(1)(a), 9(1)(r), 39, and 47 of the *National Pandemic Act 2020*, and all other enabling powers, hereby issue the follow authorization.
- 1. No person over the age of 18 is permitted to board an aircraft bound for Papua New Guinea unless they have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19 using one of the following vaccines:

a. Pfizer-BioNTech;

g. Sinovac

b. AstraZeneca-Oxford;

h. Covaxin



- 2. An individual or organisation that fails to adhere to this Direction shall be deemed to have committed an offence under the *National Pandemic Act 2020*.
- 3. A person or organisation that allows a person to board an aircraft bound for Papua New Guinea in breach of this Direction shall be deemed to have committed an offence under the *National Pandemic Act 2020*.
