REGARDING - INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL APPROVAL

- I, David Manning, Commissioner of Police and National Pandemic Controller, by virtue of sections 9(1)(a), 9(1)(r), 39, and 47 of the *National Pandemic Act 2020*, and all other enabling powers, hereby issue the follow direction;
- 1. In accordance with Measure 2, paragraph 8, an approval to enter Papua New Guinea under *Measure 2, International Travel Measures* is valid for a period of 60 days.
- 2. Measure 2, paragraph 9 is hereby revoked.
- 3. A person who has received an approval to enter Papua New Guinea in accordance with *Measure*2, *International Travel Measures*, can enter at a designated point of entry as many times as they require within the 60-day period.
- 4. For clarity, a new approval is not required for a person to leave and re-enter Papua New Guinea if a person is in possession of an approval issued in accordance with *Measure 2, International Travel Measures*, that has been approved within 60 days of arrival.
- 5. A person entering Papua New Guinea on the second or subsequent occasions whilst in possession of their original 60-day approval must satisfy all other entry requirements within *Measure 2, International Travel Measures*.

This Direction comes into effect on Friday, 28 January 2022, and continues in force during the period of the declaration of a pandemic or as amended in writing by the Controller.
